

**EVERY DAY** – Your child should be encouraged to look at the images displayed in their chosen reading books and identify what they can see. Parents are also encouraged to ask their children questions about the images to build stories within the book. Children to be encouraged to use their knowledge from Phonics sessions to say the sounds and read the words.

**EVERY WEEK**- ideally 3 x in the week – Your child should practise writing out numbers to 5, making sure they are formed correctly. They could also practise writing their name using a tripod grip position with their pencil. Children can also practice writing other labels such as names of people who live in their house and pet names.

<p><u>Week 4- 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2025</u></p> <p>Practise counting from 0-10 and from 10-0. Can you count 5 objects? Can you count 10 objects?</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> to practise writing numbers to 10 in your homework book.</p> <p><i>I have been learning these sounds in phonics:</i> n, o, p</p>	<p><u>Week 5- 30th September 2025</u></p> <p>Can you help your adults tidy up at home? Using a range of objects from around the house, can you match them to other objects that are the same?</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> How many of each object can you collect? Which group has more? Which group has less?</p> <p><i>I have been learning these sounds in phonics:</i> b, c, g, h.</p>	<p><u>Week 6- 7<sup>th</sup> October 2025</u></p> <p>Can you spot any signs of Autumn? Take pictures and upload to Tapestry or draw a picture of Autumn in your homework book.</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> collect any signs of Autumn to bring to school e.g. leaves and conkers. <i>I have been learning these sounds in phonics:</i> b, c, g, h.</p>	<p><u>Week 7- 14<sup>th</sup> October 2025</u></p> <p>Make a pattern using objects in the home. For example: cup, plate, cup, plate.</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> To make a pattern using natural objects e.g. leaf, conker, leaf, conker.</p> <p><i>I have been learning these sounds in phonics:</i> d, f, v, e.</p>
