


Reception Homework Summer 1 2026



EVERY DAY – Your child should be encouraged to look at the images displayed in their chosen reading books and identify what they can see. Parents are also encouraged to ask their children questions about the images to build stories within the book. Children to be encouraged to use their knowledge from Phonics sessions to say the sounds and read the words.

EVERY WEEK- ideally 3 x in the week – Your child should practise writing out numbers to 10, making sure they are formed correctly. They should also practise writing their name and other labels such as names of family members and pets. Children could also practice writing sentences using their phonetic knowledge.

<p><u>Week 4- 12th May 2026</u></p> <p>Read a favourite story book at home. Can you act out the story to your adults? Can you use different voices for the characters? Where is the story set?
